The Coronation will be held at 10:00 Fat Tuesday, March 4th at Lakeside during the Royal Breakfast Buffet. The Coronation is open to everyone, you do not need to participate in the Royal Buffet to see who will be crowned King & Queen of Mardi Gras 2025.

MEGA POT DRAWING

One of the most popular events during Mardi Gras is the Mega Pot Drawings. The moneys raised are used to pay for the expenses of putting on Mardi Gras. This is not a charity, as all of the money left is awarded to members during the Mardi Gras Pool Ball, including a Grand Prize of ¼ of the pot and 2 prizes of 1/8. The drawing will be at 3:00, 4:00 and the Grand Prizes at 5:00 on Fat Tuesday. The Grand prize is usually over \$1,000 and you don't need to be present to win.

Tickets are \$1 each, 6 for \$5 and 14 for \$10 and go on sale Feb.14. You can most often purchase tickets at the West Pool, near Natures Hair. Watch My Cove Friends for the location of the ticket sellers.

LAMP POST CONTEST

Cypress Cove management sponsors and conducts the Lamp Post Contest. \$350 in Cove Coins will be awarded to the best Lamp Posts, including a Grand Prize of \$175 and a Runner up of \$75 in Cove Coins. The remaining Coins will be awarded to deserving Lamp Posts at the judge's discretion. The sign-up sheet will be on the Activities Office door.

This year's theme is "The World of Mardi Gras". ". Pick a place in the world, real or imaginary, and show off their traditions. In England they call it "Pancake Day", in Rio its "Carnival" with all the lavish costumes. Just Google someplace, you'll be amazed how many interesting Mardi Gras customs there are. If it's not a Mardi Gras tradition, it should be. Join us on Pinestraw circle at 1:00 March 2, for a "bare as you dare" easy ride through the resort, lead by the Duchess of Wheels. This will be a great way to work off those pancakes.

Mardi Gras Parade

The always exciting Mardi Gras Parade steps off at 1:00 on Fat Tuesday and makes its way through the campground, ending up at the West Pool, just in time for the Mardi Gras Pool Ball.
